NEW PSYCHOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

There is a \$500 scholarship available for Psychology majors. Eligibility requirements are: at least a 3.0 GPA and ethnicity Asian or other minority student. This scholarship is renewable the 2nd year if eligibility requirements are maintained. Application deadline is July 15, 2003.

SOUTHWEST TEXAS STATE UNIVERSITY

The Southwest Texas State University Department of Technology is actively seeking qualified students to enroll in their MEET-SWT (Manufacturing Engineering and Engineering Technology at SWT) scholarship program. If qualified and selected, a student may receive up to \$3,000 annually for tuition and living expenses. The goal of the program is to graduate 30 scholars by August 2007. NAVY OFFICER PROGRAMS

The Navy ROTC program is offering three scholarship programs: Navy ROTC - for students majoring in any field; Navy Nurse Corps ROTC - for students who intend to pursue a nursing degree; and Immediate Selection Decision ROTC Scholarship. Scholarships cover all educational expenses and includes an additional monthly stipend. Packets of information about these scholarships may be picked up in the Financial Aid Office.

TRANSFERRING TO UHV - \$600 SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Houston-Victoria is accepting applications for The Johnson Scholarship. This scholarship is in the amount of \$600 and is for first time students transferring to UHV from Victoria College or Wharton County Junior College. Applicants must have at least a 2.0 GPA and enroll for at least 6 hours at UHV. All applicants must have completed at least 54 hours at a community college, or have completed 30 hours and be co-enrolled while attending UHV. This scholarship is not based on need. 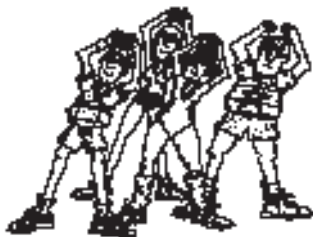
